**Lesson 23 – The Breath of God (Part 4)**

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1. No hint in OT that the “Breath of God” is a distinct person.
  - A. The literal meaning – “Breath” – makes good sense in every case.
  - B. Many passages become nonsensical if the “pneuma of God” is translated as “Spirit” (*ex. He will destroy the wicked with the Spirit of His nostrils*).
  
2. Does the NT set an initial precedent?
  - A. Who’s Your Daddy? Luke 1:35; Matt. 1:20
  - B. Who was in Jesus doing the miracles? John 10:37-38; John 14:6-11; Matt. 12:28; Acts 10:37-38
  - C. Why is the ‘Holy Ghost’ IGNORANT of the Father and the Son? Luke 10:21-22
  - D. Why is the Holy Ghost AWOL? John 17:ALL (esp. 21)
