Lesson 7 – Detour through Samaria (Part 2)

- I. Woman's history revealed provides authority for Jesus' words (vss. 16-18)
 - A. Marital history or past fornication no obstacle to salvation.
 - B. She did not have to return to her first husband.
- II. True Worship of God by His own sons and daughters (vss. 19-20)
 - A. Debate between Jews and Samaritans concerning the place of worship.
 - 1. Deut. 11:26 – 12:7; Deut. 27:1-13; Josh. 8:30-35
 - 2. The Samaritan Pentateuch (5 books of Moses), accept as Scripture, reject the "prophets" as infallible Scripture
 - 3. Salvation is of the Jews (of "Judah" – the Davidic Covenant & promised "Messiah" of David's seed)
 - B. Worship in IGNORANCE vs. worship in Spirit & truth (vss. 21-25)
 - 1. Vs. 22 You worship in ignorance
 - a. Acts 10:1-8, 22, 47-48; Acts 17:29-31
 - 2. Vs. 23-24 "true worship" in spirit and truth (knowledge)
 - a. Eph. 4:17-24; 1 Pet. 1:14,22; 2 Pet. 1:2-4; 2 Pet. 2:20
 - 3. Vss. 25-26 She had SOME knowledge of the source of knowledge
 - a. "Messiah" refers to the "Anointed" king from David
