Exodus Part 3: Moses instructed by God 40 days on Mt. Sinai

- A. Exod. 21-23 Various laws for Israel
 - 1. Exod. 21:1-2 The <u>Sabbatical Year</u> (Lev. 25; Deut. 15:9; Jer. 34:13-16)
 - 2. Exod. 23:12 The weekly Sabbath command repeated (cf. 31:15-17; 34:21; 35:2)
- B. Exod. 24
 - 1. Vss. 9-11 Moses, Aaron and his 2 sons, and 70 elders ascend partway up Mt. Sinai & they all "*saw the God of Israel*; and under His feet there appeared to be a pavement of sapphire, as clear as the sky itself."
 - a. Ezek. 1:26-28 Ezekiel's vision of the Son
 - b. John 1:18 No one has ever seen the Father; they saw His Messenger, Son (John 5:37; John 6:46; Col. 1:15; 1 Tim. 1:17; 1 Tim. 8:16; 1 John 4:12)
 - 2. Vss. 12-18 Moses enters the cloud at the top of Mt. Sinai <u>on the Sabbath</u>, and remains 40 days fasting, receives the stone tablets w/10 Commandments
 - a. 1 Kings 19:1-18 Elijah's experience on Mt. Sinai with God's Son 1. vss. 11-12, God did not speak through the wind, fire, and earthquake (as with Moses), but in "a still small voice" (Jesus).
 - b. Mark 9:1-9 "After 6 days" (on the Sabbath) Jesus took 3 disciples into a high mountain, into the cloud to see His glory (Moses & Elijah).
- C. Exod. 25-34 Instructions for God's Tabernacle (Heb. 8:1-6; Rev. 15:5-6; Rev. 21:3)
 - 1. Exod. 25 The furnishings inside the Tabernacle
 - a. vss. 1-22 The Ark of the Covenant
 - b. vss. 23-30 The Table of Showbread
 - c. vss. 31-40 The Menorah (Lampstand)
 - 2. Exod. 26 The Structure of the Tabernacle, its coverings and veils
 - 3. Exod. 27 The Courtyard & Altar of Sacrifice before the Tabernacle
 - 4. Exod. 28 the priest's robes
 - 5. Exod. 29 Consecration of the priests
 - 6. Exod. 30 The altar of incense (Rev. 8:3)
 - 7. Exod. 31 God's Spirit gives skill to certain workmen & Sabbath vss. 13-18
- D. Exod 32 The "Golden Calf" made by Aaron & God's judgement
 - 1. vs. 19 Moses breaks the stone tablets
 - 2. vss. 20-24 The high priest Aaron blames the people
 - 3. vss. 25-30 The priests kill 3000 people who instigated the idolatry
 - 4. vss. 31-35 Sinner blotted out of God's Book (Rev. 3:5; Rev. 20:12-15)
- E. Exod. 33 The "Messenger" of God's FACE (Presence) leads the way (Exod. 23:20-23;
- 32:34; Jdg. 2:1-4; Isa. 63:9) who is the Son (Isa. 9:6 {LXX}; Mal. 3:1; Rev. 1:1-2)
- F. Exod 34 New Stone Tablets; Moses' face glowed (2 Cor. 3:11-18; cf. Matt. 17:2)
- G. Exod. 35-40 Moses fabricates tabernacle pieces according to God's specifications
 - 1. Exod. 40:1 Tabernacle erected on the 1st of Nisan (1st month {April})
