## "I am ..." ἐγώ εἰμι (ego eimi)

- I. Predicate nominative clause includes:
  - 1. Subject "I"  $\dot{\epsilon}\gamma\dot{\omega}$  (1st person, singular pronoun)
  - 2. Stative verb "am" εἰμι (present, 1st person, singular)
  - 3. Predicate (what is stated about this person) can either be <u>stated</u> directly, or <u>implied</u> by what is in question or being challenged in the immediate context.

## II. Predicate **stated**:

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"I am the bread of life" (Jn. 6:48)
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## III. Predicate <u>implied by what is in question or challenged in the immediate</u> context:

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Jn. 4:26 "I am" (the Messiah, v. 25)
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Jn. 8:24 "I am" (from above & not of this world, v. 23)
