Module XI – Revelation

Lesson 49 – Rev. 19:14-21

I. The Second coming of Logos the Son of God, Jesus the Anointed

A. 2nd coming appears 4 times: (Rev. 6:12-17; Rev. 11:15-18; Rev. 14:14-20; Rev. 19:11-21)

B. Vs. 14

1. “armies” = military forces (angels) not Christians

a. Zech. 14:5; Matt. 25:31; Luke 9:26; 1 Thess. 3:13

B. White and clean robes = holiness (the “holy angels” excludes those who sinned)

C. Vs. 15

1. The sword out of His mouth = He speaks the word, & enemies fall by God’s power.

a. Previously, Jesus spoke only as He heard from God (John 5:30; John 12:47-50)

1. Yet it was the Breath of God that actually performed the miraculous (John 14:10; Acts 2:22; Acts 10:36-38)

b. At His second coming and Kingdom, He will be “God” – sole Sovereign. He will not rely on the Father to direct Him, but He will judge independently, based on the miraculous knowledge from God’s Breath (Psalm 45:6-7; Isa. 11:1-5).

2. Quote from Psalm 2:9 LXX

3. The “winepress” drawn from Joel 3:13; Rev. 14:17-20

D. Vs. 16

1. Now the Father possesses the title, “*King of kings and Lord of Lords*” (1 Tim. 6:15)

2. This indicates that the Father has transferred sole sovereignty to the Son

a. Dan. 7:8-10,13-14

b. 1 Cor. 15:22-28

E. Vs. 17-18

1. God calls the buzzards to consume the carnage, a prophecy frequently used for God’s overthrowing armies in battle

a. Jer. 7:31; Jer. 16:4; Jer. 19:7; Jer. 34:15 Nebuchadnezzar’s overthrow of Judah

b. Ezek. 29:5; Ezek. 32:4 Nebuchadnezzar’s overthrow of Pharaoh

c. Ezek. 39:4 Judgement of “Gog-Magog” at the end of the Millennium (Rev. 20)

F. Vs. 19

1. Previously assembled TO battle against Christ and His army (Rev. 16:12-16)

G. Vs. 20

1. Both “beasts” in Rev. 13 captured

2. Thrown ALIVE into Gehenna – the “lake of fire”

a. 2 Thess. 2:3-10 – “consumed” by the “breath of His mouth”

b. He must therefore be “consumed” in Gehenna

c. “Cast alive” is in contrast to the rest of humanity whose CORPSES are thrown into Gehenna (Isa. 66:15-16,22-24 & Mark 9:43-48)

H. Vs. 21

3. Remaining armies destroyed with a word (2 Thess. 1:9-10, Zech. 14:12-13)
