Lesson 58 - Rev. 22:1-5

I. Chapter 22

- A. Vss. 1-5 The "river of the water of life" drawn from Ezekiel 47:1-12
 - 1. The water flows from under the threshold of the Temple which faces east.
 - a. In Rev. 22: 1 the source is the "Throne of God and the Lamb."
 - 1. It is called the "Throne of God" because:
 - a. the authority is delegated by God
 - b. the Son is "God" while reigning (Psalm 45:6-7)
 - 2. The Son alone sits on this throne (Rev. 3:21 & 7:15-17).
 - 3. It is also the "Throne of David" (Isa. 9:6-7; Luke 1:31-32; Acts 2:29-30)
 - 4. Jerusalem will be called "the Throne of YHVH" (Jer. 3:16-17)
 - 2. v. 2 The Tree of Life is in the median of the street leading to the entrance of the Temple, and on both sides of the river that flows from the Temple to the Dead Sea.
 - 3. v. 3
- a. every curse abolished for the righteous:
 - 1. the curse of death (1 Cor. 15:53-57)
 - 2. the curse on the ground (Gen. 3:17; Rom. 8:18-25)
- b. "His servants," pronoun refers to the God/Lamb (servants of the Son)
- 4. vs. 4
 - a. They will see the face of the Son (1 John 3:2)
 - b. The Son's name will be on their foreheads (Rev. 3:12)
- 5. vs. 5
 - a. God will illuminate the entire city day and night (Isa. 60:18-21)
 - b. they reign unto ages of ages (1000 years Rev. 20:4)
